



DESCRIPTION OF THE TWO STONES:


Head-End



Approx.
8CM
Apprx.

- Russet stone with small black pits covering the surface area.
- Texture of the surface is in between smooth and rough, but closer to smooth
- The shape of the russet stone resembles an ellipse with one end slightly wider than the other

Pointed End



- Black stone with grey and brown wavy lines sparsely dispersed over the surface
- Texture of the surface is smooth
- The shape of the black stone resembles a bird's head and its beak, or a rounded spear head.
