



Tuition for Graduate Credit

University of Guelph Graduate Students attending the Summer Institute for academic credit are required to register with the University of Guelph as well as the Summer Institute. Tuition and fees are paid to the University according to the tuition rates set by the University. Please note that the Summer Institute does not charge any additional fees to graduate students registered at the University of Guelph over the summer term. Graduate Students from other universities will be required to pay the Summer Institute Summer Scholar fee (see below). They are encouraged to apply to their home institution for reimbursement of this fee and for possible academic credit.

Fee for Participation without Academic Credit

Participants who wish to attend the Summer Institute without receiving academic credit will be registered as Summer Scholars and will pay their fees directly to the Summer Institute. No transcript will be issued but participants will receive a certificate of attendance.

Summer Scholar Fee: \$300 CDN

Fee for Attending Keynote Lectures

The keynote lectures will be open to the general public for a fee of \$10.00 per lecture.
