

Tuition for Graduate Credit

University of Guelph and Memorial University Graduate Students attending the Summer Institute for academic credit are required to register with the University of Guelph or Memorial University as well as the Summer Institute. Tuition and fees are paid to the University according to the tuition rates set by the University. The Summer Institute Scholar Fee is required by all course participants (see below).

Note: University of Guelph students may register in UNIV6040 Critical Studies in Improvisation in either the summer or fall term.

Memorial students may register in Music 7806/Education 6920.

Graduate Students from other universities will be required to pay the Summer Institute Summer Scholar fee (see below). They are encouraged to apply to their home institution for reimbursement of this fee and for possible academic credit.
